

EXHIBITION OPPORTUNITIES

The third and final day of the conference is dedicated to the running of ongoing professional development and training. AIG wishes to encourage organisations and service providers to present technical workshops, forums and information sharing seminars to conference delegates. There are opportunities to present half day and full day workshops in a range of areas including drilling logistics and contract management, drilling techniques and practices, drill core logging technologies, borehole geophysics, analytical techniques and data management, analysis and interpretation or other related topics.

It is anticipated that many of the post-conference workshops will be held at the Royal on the Park which has excellent facilities and can cater from 5 to 50 workshop participants in each of its meeting rooms.
